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INTRODUCTION

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This Final State Fiscal Year 2009 (SFY '09) Kansas Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (KWPCRF) Project Priority List is based upon the Final SFY 2009 Kansas Water Pollution Control Project Priority System dated December 2008. The Priority List is prepared consistent with the April 29, 1988, guidance from EPA and the October 1996 Clean Water State Revolving Fund Funding Framework prepared by EPA.

The Water Quality Act of 1987 (WQA of 1987) became law on February 4, 1987. These amendments call for several minor changes and the phase-out of the construction grants program; however, the main thrust of the amendments was establishment of Title VI - State Water Pollution Control Revolving Funds (SRF's). K.S.A. 65-3321 through 65-3329 authorizes establishment of the Kansas Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund (KWPCRF), for which KDHE has accepted Title VI capitalization grants, and allows KDHE to administer this new low interest loan fund for construction of water pollution control projects.

The WQA of 1987 requires that for a specific project to be eligible to receive a loan of Clean Water Act SRF (KWPCRF) monies, the project must be identified on the Priority List. Projects are "targeted" or "chosen" for KWPCRF loans by being placed in the Intended Use Plan (IUP).

Kansas has now received the FFY '08 capitalization grant and has applied for the FFY '09 capitalization grant for the Kansas Clean Water SRF. This grant is expected to be received in the near future. Reauthorization of the Clean Water Act continues to be debated in Congress, but FFY '09 Capitalization Grant funding in the amount \$6,104,200 will be received. This Final SFY '09 Priority List and the Final SFY '09 Intended Use Plan are based on the anticipated FFY '09 Capitalization Grant amount of \$6,104,200, the recent sale of \$5.6 M State Match Bonds and \$60 M of Leveraging Bonds, and the future sale of an additional \$90 M of Leveraging Bonds.

KDHE, in conjunction with the Kansas Development Finance Authority (KDFA), continues to conduct financial and legal analysis of the concept of "leveraging" additional monies for the Kansas SRF Program, i.e. borrowing more than the basic required 20% State Match to the EPA Capitalization Grant, and this option is utilized at every opportunity.

Due to the great popularity of the KWPCRF and continued requests for funding by high priority water quality and sludge treatment (biosolids) projects, KDHE frequently reviews the financial capability of the Fund. These reviews, which also consider present

financial conditions in the bond market, have determined the KWPCRF should again develop and market "Leveraging" Revenue Bonds. KDHE working in conjunction with KDFA is now routinely marketing State Match and Leveraging Bonds, and completed the sale of additional Leveraging Bonds in December 2008 for \$60,000,000. Additional "State Match" Revenue Bonds were also be sold at that time in the amount of \$5,600,000 as necessary to match prior and expected Federal grants. The bond amounts do not include bond funds required for reserve accounts or fees and expenses. KDHE is continuing to work with KDFA and the financial advisors to the program to develop and market additional leveraging bonds, and approximately \$90 M of leveraging bonds are anticipated to be sold in the future.

A project must be included in the IUP to actually receive a KWPCRF loan. KDHE will continue to utilize the Priority Ranking System and Priority List to aid in identifying the projects with the greatest need to proceed with a project. Therefore, projects will be considered in order of priority from the list for inclusion on the IUP, and subsequent receipt of a low interest KWPCRF loan.

In response to comments during the FFY '93 Public Hearing, KDHE will consider projects for the upgrade and elimination of residuals from municipally-owned drinking water treatment facilities allowable for KWPCRF low interest loans. Such projects are allowable under Title VI of the Clean Water Act, however only construction necessary to improve or eliminate the discharge is an allowable cost, i.e. construction to expand/enhance water production is not allowable from the Clean Water SRF. Such projects can be funded by the Drinking Water SRF also administered by KDHE.

The priority system is designed to give the highest weight to projects which most affect stream quality, particularly streams identified for drinking water supplies, swimming and wading, and recognized fisheries. The impact of this approach is evident as the highest ranked projects are treatment plant upgrades to comply with Surface Water Quality Standards. As ongoing KDHE field studies, stream impact analyses, toxicity testing as required by NPDES permits, etc., and the Municipality's efforts in gathering additional effluent data and developing engineering studies become available, this new information is utilized in developing accurate, up to date rankings. Available information is utilized in ranking projects and adding additional potential projects to the List.

The priority system ranking criteria for "Discharge to High Quality Watersheds" was revised in FFY 1996, to recognize the Governor's Initiative in the Kansas/Lower Republican River Basin by providing additional priority points for projects located within these river basins. This section was also expanded in FFY 1997 to provide priority points for projects which result from Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) studies. As these studies are completed any project for pollution abatement identified as necessary to satisfy a TMDL

to restore or protect stream segment water quality conditions will be provided additional priority points. This section was revised again in FFY 1999 to better reflect the 1999 Kansas Surface Water Quality Standards. The EPA Funding Framework is the reference to allow and prioritize Non-point Source Pollution Control projects.

Projects correcting basement flooding, overflows and bypasses also receive priority. Infiltration/inflow correction and/or sewage overflow correction projects are loan eligible. Innovative or alternative projects, lagoons and regional systems are awarded a higher rank to encourage their use. This is in conformance with the State Water Quality Management Plan. A higher rank is provided if the recipient's county or planning area has a Countywide Wastewater Management Plan, Local Environmental Protection Program, water pollution abatement plan, or a similar sewer and water development plan which has been implemented. Enforcement actions are not considered in developing priority rankings. A public health hazard declaration is an overriding factor in assigning priority points.

The WQA of 1987 required EPA develop sludge management program regulations and technical criteria regulations for disposal of municipal sanitary sewage sludge. These regulations of criteria are now complete, having been published in 40 CFR Part 503 dated February 19, 1993. Treatment facilities have been added to the list which, based on presently available information, may require upgrading to comply with these criteria.

Collection system projects were ranked on the basis of information available within the Bureau's files and known to Bureau staff. If additional information on particular projects is available which might not have been considered in ranking a project, please inform this Bureau. The information should be presented in a format consistent with the ranking procedure.

The priority system and priority list were revised in FFY 1996 to provide funding for Non-Point Source Pollution Control Management Plan Implementation projects. The Master Bond Resolution was revised in 2000 to create the Environmental Initiatives Fund (EIF) to allow funding to "non-traditional" borrowers. The policies and procedures for priority ranking will be developed by a separate effort within KDHE and so will be presented at a future time. As these policies and procedures are completed following public review and input Public Hearing, these will be incorporated into the KWPCRF program. Funds can now be placed in the EIF for "non-traditional" projects, including Non-Point Source Pollution Control Management Plan projects. These funds come directly from the Repayment of Principle monies of the KWPCRF, and are transferred on a project-specific as-needed basis.

Clean Water SRF projects can receive a loan for 100% of project costs, but project costs are limited to administration, engineering, and construction costs of the water pollution control project. The enabling Federal legislation does not allow the cost of land, easements, or private I/I removal within a Clean Water SRF project.

To receive additional priority points for selection of an I/A alternative, a majority of the project must be involved with the I/A concept. For example, a project will not receive extra points only because a sludge hauling vehicle or anaerobic digesters are utilized.

For Clean Water SRF low interest loan projects, all contract costs of project development (planning, design, financial capability, etc.) are initially the responsibility of the potential loan recipient, but can be included with total project costs when a loan is actually provided. The estimated loan amounts are reflected in the "Tot.\$" column, as loans would be for the total project cost.

The Clean Water SRF Program includes two State Management set-asides to be established. The 604(b) - State Management/Non-Point Source set-aside is 1% of the State of Kansas allotment of Title VI funds, or a minimum of \$100,000. The STATUS OF FUNDS sheet shows this FFY 2009 604(b)reserve.

The 603(d)(7) - SRF Management is the second set-aside and is 4% of the actual capitalization grant received by KDHE for the Clean Water SRF. For the FFY 2009 capitalization grant, we again propose to set-aside the maximum allowable 4% of the capitalization grant. KDHE is tracking use of Administrative monies very closely, and has established a fee to generate future administrative monies to use after the 603(d)(7) grant monies are depleted. Please note the funds from this set-aside can be used for Clean Water SRF management only, and if less than the total set-aside amount is actually used, the balance remains in the fund. EPA has finalized a new Policy regarding these Service Fees dated October 20, 2005, and Appendix D of the Intended Use Plan presents information on this subject.

K.S.A. 65-3324 requires a set-aside for Small Communities (5,000 or Less population) also be established which ensures at least 10% of the total dollar amount of loans each year be made available for projects of municipalities having a population of 5,000 or less. If these set-aside monies are not utilized by small communities, the unused amount is then available for projects of other municipalities. All communities with 5,000 or less population are identified on the list with one * next to the project name. We encourage communities of 5,000 or less to develop projects and utilize this funding source.
